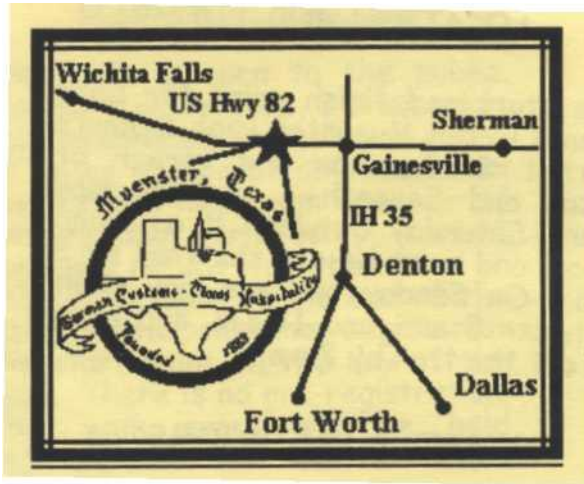
Saint Jo

Saint Jo Civic Center, 100 E Boggess St, Saint Jo, Texas

From IH-35, take exit 498B in Gainesville for US-82 W towards Wichita Falls. Saint Jo is 22 miles west of IH-35 and 9 miles west of Muenster. The starting point is just north of US-82W on the town square.

From North or South on IH35, take exit #498 (Hwy 82), Go West 13 miles to Muenster. Turn RIGHT on Mesquite St. Turn LEFT on Seventh St.

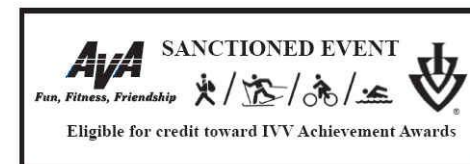

START POINT

Muenster High School Hornet Stadium
215 E 9th Street, Muenster, Texas.

START / FINISH TIMES

8:00 a.m. – Noon, finish by 3:00 pm.

RESTROOMS AND WATER

Water and restrooms are available at the Start and at the checkpoint.

PETS

Pets are welcome, but must be kept on leash. Clean up is required.
