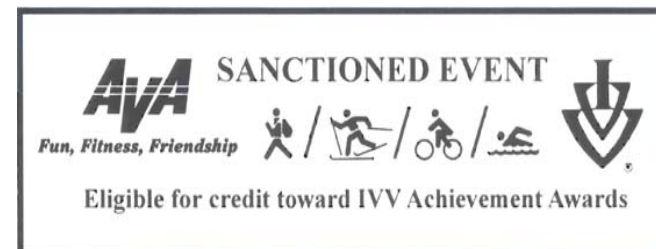

Southbound on US 69/75 at Exit 73, continue on US 69 South. Chestnut Street is one block past Main Street. Turn right for 6 blocks to Start Point. **Northbound** on US 75, take Spur 503, Exit 66, to US 69. Continue North on US 69 to Chestnut Street. Turn left for 6 blocks to Start Point.



The STAR TREKKERS of Irving invite you to historic Denison, Texas, birthplace of President Dwight D. Eisenhower. Denison's main street district contains arts, antiques, and specialty stores. The neighborhoods adjacent to the downtown area contain many historical buildings build in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

START/FINISH: Central Fire Station, 700 W. Chestnut, Denison, TX 75020. You may start anytime between dawn and 3 hours before dusk. The walk must be finished by dark. There are no refunds. Event takes place rain or shine.

TRAIL AND RATING: The trail is a historical walk that will take you pass 34 points of interest including Eisenhower's Birthplace and The Old Katy Railroad Depot It is suitable for strollers even though some of the walkways will not be on sidewalks but on the street. We are rating it 1+. Wheelchairs may be difficult due to railroad tracks and some curb jumping.

AWARD: "B" awards are 3" tile containing the Texas Amblers logo will be awarded. A limited number of "B" awards are be available for \$1.00 each.

REGISTRATION: There is no pre-registration. The Start/Finish is located in the office of the Central Fire Station. Identify yourself as a Volksmarch participant and ask for the Volksmarch box. Please be patient if there is an emergency, All walkers must be registered and have a start card.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. This event is open to all. An adult must accompany children under 12. Pets are welcome, but must be kept on a leash at all times. Pets are not allowed inside any of the buildings. Please clean up after pet.

EVENT CONDITIONS: Caution is advised when walking along and crossing city streets. Please walk on left side of route unless directions state otherwise. When you register for this event, you accept the guidelines for AVA Volkssport events and agree to observe the principles of good sportsmanship. Littering is not permitted. Restrooms and water are both available at the Fire Station and several stores and restaurants along the route.

Denison is located in northeastern Grayson County on U.S. Highway 75, just 75 miles north of Dallas and 4 miles south of the Texas/Oklahoma border. State Highway 120 passes through Denison from east to west, and State Highway 84 borders northern Denison, providing direct access to Lake Texoma, the twelfth largest man-made lake in the U.S. Gently rolling and wooded terrain stretches northward to the shores of Lake Texoma and the Red River.
